Nomad X Treme Bikes and Delivery Co. LTD ("Company", "we", "us" "Our")

GOVERNING THAI LAW. This rental arrangement is generally treated as a hire of property / hire contract under Thailand's Civil and Commercial Code (CCC) (hire of property provisions include Section 537 onward). *[Ref 1]*

CONTROLLED CONTRACT RULES (IMPORTANT). Car and motorcycle rental services to consumers are treated as a controlled contract business under Office of the Consumer Protection Board (OCPB) contract standards effective 30 December 2025. The signable contract will be in Thai as well and will follow mandatory/prohibited clause rules. *[Ref 2]*

CONSUMER PROTECTION AND UNFAIR TERMS. Thailand has laws restricting unfair contract terms and consumer contract abuses (including the Consumer Protection Act and Unfair Contract Terms Act). *[Ref 3]*

This document is intended to be used as a "Control Contract" for motorcycle and motorcycle rental services in accordance with the Notification of the Contract Commission B.E. 2568 (effective from 30 December 2025 onwards) and shall be construed in accordance with the Consumer Protection Law of Thailand.

BIKE / MOTORCYCLE: The rented motorcycle including keys, accessories, documents and any provided equipment.

CUSTOMER / RENTER / YOU: The person (s) renting and signing the Rental Agreement. There can only be one primary renter.

MINIMUM AGE: Twenty-Three (23) years old, individuals 18-22 need to have a parental signer as the primary to the contract with the parents located in Thailand during the rental. The individual 18-22 will be listed as a authorized rider.

AUTHORIZED RIDER: The Customer and any additional rider expressly approved in writing by the Company.

RENTAL PERIOD: The period from handover time to return time as stated in the Rental Agreement.

RENTAL DAY: Twenty-four (24) hour period (unless stated otherwise in the Rental Agreement).

SECURITY DEPOSIT: A refundable amount held to mitigate risk and cover charges/damages.

INSPECTION RECORD: Photos/Videos taken at pickup and return used to assess condition and damages.

TYPE 3 INSURANCE: Thailand third-party liability coverage only (not comprehensive).

1.4 INSURANCE

All motorcycles are covered by Type 3 (Third Party Liability) - the Motor Accident Victims Protection Act (compulsory) as required by Thai Law. Compulsory insurance (Por Ror Bor): Thailand requires compulsory motor insurance for registered vehicles under the Protection for Motor Vehicle Victims Act B.E. 2535 (1992). [Ref 6]

Coverage for the motorcycle itself may be offered as a part of the Nomad X Club under the Bronze, Gold, and Platinum Memberships. These special coverages and exemptions do not negate or invalidate this document.

Rider/Passenger injuries damage, water damage, negligence, or misuse, unless a supplemental agreement/policy is provided are not covered under Type 3 insurance and no coverage is offered by Nomad X Treme Bikes and Delivery Co. LTD. except as provided in our membership packages.

☐ Signing or not signing this document at pick-up or online during the reservations process, by accepting delivery of the motorcycle binds the renter(s) to its terms and provides notice to each customer. Customer Initial_____

You accept full financial responsibility for losses not covered by Type 3 insurance. You are strongly advised to arrange your own travel/medical coverage and any additional insurance you deem necessary.

The Renter is assumed to have read and understood this document and is on notice regarding the insurance coverage limitations and accepts the risks/liabilities of the contract (*See also Release of Liability Documents) and Thai Law.

PART 2: MOTORCYCLE RENTAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

2.1 CONTRACT FORM AND COMPLIANCE WITH CONSUMER PROTECTION LAW

2.1.1 This Agreement is prepared in English & Thai which will prevail the English version. The letters are clearly legible and have complete details. Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. will immediately deliver the signed contract to the Customer (or in an electronic form as required by law).

2.1.2 If any of the clauses in this Agreement contradict the law/notice that the govern this contract, it shall be interpreted and applied in accordance with Thai Law. Statements prohibited by law shall be deemed invalid.

2.2 RENTERS AND AUTHORIZED RIDER QUALIFICATIONS

2.2.1 The Renter and the licensed rider must have a motorcycle driving license valid in Thailand for the entire rental period. In the case of foreigners, they must posses

- (a) an International Motorcycle License which is valid in Thailand and not expired, or
- (b) a valid Thai Motorcycle license.

2.2.2 No other person specified as an "Authorized Rider" shall be allowed to drive the Motorcycle under any circumstances.

2.2.3 The rider and passenger must wear helmets in accordance with the Thai Traffic Law at all times when using the motorcycle. **[Ref 4]**

2.2.4 Minimum Age for rental, Twenty-Three (23) years old, individuals eighteen to twenty-two (18-22) years old need to have a parental signer as the primary to the contract with the parents located in Thailand during the rental period. The individuals eighteen to twenty-two (18-22) will be listed as a authorized rider.

2.2.5 The rider affirms upon taking possession of the motorcycle they are physically and mentally fit to ride a high-powered motorcycle. The Company may refuse rental or handover (without liability) if, in our reasonable judgment, documentation is insufficient or you appear impaired or unsafe.

2.3 RESERVATIONS PAYMENT AND RENTAL CONFIRMATION

2.3.1 The booking will be complete when the Renter pays the specified amount (partial/total and/or security deposit) within the deadline. If the payment is not made before pick-up, Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. has the right to give the motorcycle to another customer.

2.3.2 Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. must clearly disclose all service charges, fees and fines (Appendix 1) and will not charge anything other than specified unless the customer agrees in writing.

2.3.3. Nomad X Treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. collects taxes on each transaction and pays this to the Kingdom of Thailand. However, transactions are typically listed and priced in USD then converted Thai Baht.

2.4 CANCELLATION / NO-SHOW

2.4.1 If the Renter does not pick up the motorcycle within 3 hours from the agreed pick-up time and does not contact Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. Staff, it shall be considered as a default/cancellation of the rental and one day (1) rental charge will be assessed.

2.4.2 The refund (if any) shall be calculated based on the number of rental days that the customer has reserved the motorcycle, of which twenty-four (24) hours shall be counted as one (1) rental day, and the actual expenses incurred shall be deducted from the available deposit or credit card on file as described on the customer's invoice or third-party processor and the details of the calculation shall be provided to the customer.

2.4.3 Cancellation of a paid contract within 24 hours of the pickup will result in a day charge based on the rental rate of the selected motorcycle. This charge is waiverable at the companies discretion.

2.5 MOTORCYCLE DELIVERY/RETURN AND BUSINESS HOURS

2.5.1 Delivery/Return of the motorcycle is available from 08:00–20:00 every day with text/email responses between 08:00–20:00; Responses outside these times may vary but is available particularly for emergencies which should be indicated in the text or email or cell message as provided on our website. Contact Nomad X Staff to coordinate alternative pick-up or return times, availability is not guaranteed.

2.5.2 Public Holidays: Deliveries must be coordinated in advance and additional charges may apply as disclosed in advance.

2.6 CORRECT USE OF THE MOTORCYCLE

2.6.1 The Renter must use the motorcycle with reasonable and normal manner. It is used for driving on public roads in Thailand and obeying traffic laws. Nomad X treme Bikes and Delivery Co. Ltd. makes no assurances about the suitability of Thai roads or guarantees about the suitability for riding our motorcycles. The rider must exercise good judgement on the terrain they traverse with the motorcycle they have leased. Nomad X treme bikes provides no insurance for accidents related to

for example smooth roads, wet roads, objects in the roads, pot holes, and other road or off road conditions.

2.6.2 Do not use the motorcycle in competitive/track/stunt/dangerous speed events. For off-road use, driving through flood/deep water/beaches, or applications where there is a risk of engine, structural, and/or electrical damage. ***Do not ignore motorcycle warning lights or continue to ride with a mechanical issue.***

2.6.3 Do not drive while intoxicated, alcohol in excess of the law, or under the influence of drugs. If damaged, the lessee is responsible for all damages in accordance with the contract and the law.

2.6.4 The customer is responsible for safe and lawful operation at all times, securing the motorcycle when unattended, and preventing water damage, negligence, or misuse.

2.6.5 **DO NOT TAKE THE MOTORCYCLE OUTSIDE THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND.** Do not sublease, borrow, or transfer the right to use the motorcycle to another person.

2.7 FUEL AND CLEANLINESS

2.7.1 The Renter must return the motorcycle with the agreed fuel/battery power level. If it is less than the pick-up level, the customer must pay for the fuel/energy difference and refill service fee at the rates noted in Annex 1. **MOST IF NOT ALL OUR MOTORCYCLES MUST USE (95 OR 97) OCTANE FUEL.**

2.7.2 The Customer shall maintain reasonable cleanliness. If there are any unusual amounts of (sand/mud/seawater) or road contaminants. Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. may charge additional fees at the rate in Appendix 1, provided that the reason and evidence are presented to the customer.

2.8 TRACKING SYSTEM (GPS) AND PERSONAL INFORMATION (PDPA) [Ref 7]

2.8.1 All motorcycles are equipped with GPS systems for safety, theft prevention, and motorcycle recovery. The Renter consents to the tracking of the motorcycle's location during the rental period.

2.8.2 The Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. will collect, use and disclose Personal Data as necessary for the stated purposes and comply with the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (PDPA). Under the terms of the law.

2.8.3 Customers are prohibited from removing or cutting off the power. Block or render the GPS system unusable. Such an act is considered a significant breach of contract and the Nomad X treme

Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. has the right to take measures to recover the motorcycle and collect necessary expenses.

2.9 MOTORCYCLE INSPECTION AND EVIDENCE

2.9.1 The Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. and the lessee will inspect the condition of the motorcycle on the date of pick-up and return of the motorcycle, along with recording photos/videos and preparing the inspection documents or iPad software at the end of the contract.

2.9.2 Photo/video evidence and inspection documents are used as evidence for determining damages. If the customer objects, the customer can file an objection with evidence within [5] Days from the date of receipt of the notification of damages.

2.10 ACCIDENTS, THEFTS, AND INCIDENT REPORTING

2.10.1 In the event of an accident, damage or abnormality, the Renter must stop the motorcycle safely. Notify Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. immediately and notify the police/relevant agencies as appropriate, along with collecting/sending evidence such as photographs/videos, names of the parties, cell numbers, emails, addresses, etc.

2.10.2 In case of loss/theft of the motorcycle, the customer must immediately report to the police and send a copy of the notice to the Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. as soon as possible.

2.11 MAINTENANCE, MOTORCYCLE BREAKDOWN, AND REPLACEMENT MOTORCYCLE

2.11.1 The Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. will deliver the motorcycle in a reasonably ready condition. If the motorcycle breaks down due to causes that are not the Renter's fault. The operator will endeavour to provide a replacement motorcycle (if any) or refund the rental fee for the period when the motorcycle cannot be used, as appropriate.

2.11.2 The Renter shall not repair or modify the motorcycle without written permission, except as a precaution against an emergency hazard so as not to cause additional damage.

2.12 SECURITY DEPOSIT/DEPOSIT DEDUCTIONS AND REFUNDS [Ref 5]

2.12.1 The security deposit is intended to guarantee the performance of the contract and pay the costs incurred by the lessee under the contract/law. Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. will not forfeit or deduct the security deposit if the customer does not breach the contract or does not violate material conditions of the contract.

2.12.2 The deduction of the security deposit can only be made if there is clear cause and evidence, such as the cost of repairing damage caused by the customer's use. Replacement of lost property (keys, documents, equipment), late return fines, and any unusual cleaning fees or fees/expenses that the customer is liable for under Appendix 1.

2.12.3 When the Renter returns the motorcycle and equipment. Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. will immediately (unless return times/weather or other uncontrollable circumstances causes a delay in the inspection process) inspect the condition of the motorcycle and equipment and refund the security deposit/deposit under Clause 1.3 to the lessee by complying with the following rules of the control contract:

(A) In case the motorcycle and equipment are not damaged, damaged or lost: Full refund

(A.1) If the Renter pays the security deposit in cash/transfer/cheque/credit card/crypto: The refund will be return within ten (10) days the date the Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. receives the motorcycle and/or refund initiated in accords with the limitations of the payment or security method (For Example: a Credit Card refund may take 3-7 days to credit back to the customer.

(A.2). In case of damage or loss caused by the Renter's fault during the customer's possession: Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. has the right to deduct/charge only for the actual damage (s), as necessary, provided that verifiable evidence (e.g. photographs/videos, inspection reports, quotations or receipts) exist. Refund differences will be process after the repairs are completed or at the discretion of Nomad X Treme Bikes when a good faith repair estimate has been established. The Customer has the right to present up to three (3) alternate repair shops or solutions which will result in the equivalent repair outcome. Nomad X Treme has the right of refusal if such repairs would not suffice or remedy the damage (a.1) or (a.2) The customer has the right to a copy of a prepare summary of the deduction resulting from the damages or other applicable fees or applied charges.

2.13 LATE RETURN OF THE MOTORCYCLE

2.13.1 The Renter must return the motorcycle on the agreed date and time. If the motorcycle is returned late three (3) hours or more without contacting Nomad X Staff, an additional day or days will be charged. The customer must pay penalties/additional cost as described in Annex 1.

2.13.2 Rental extension must be agreed by both parties before the deadline for returning the motorcycle.

2.13.3 EARLY RETURN: If the Renter wishes to return the motorcycle before the end date/time of the rental, rates will be re-calculated which may result in charges higher than the customer was previously invoiced. Longer rentals durations are charged at lower rates and consequently early returns could result in higher rates being applied. The lessee must notify the Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. in advance via text/email/cell

(a) in the case of daily rentals or

(b) in the case of extended rental less than ninety-three (93) days

2.13.4 When the lessee returns the motorcycle before the deadline under Clause 2.13.3 and Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. has received the motorcycle. Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. will return the rental amount in proportion to the remaining lease period to the customer and refund the security deposit according to Clause 2.12.3. Refunds may be adjusted for higher rates for early return of the motorcycle.

2.14 TRAFFIC FINES AND EXPENSES FOR ILLEGAL ACTS

2.14.1 The Renter is responsible for fines, fees and expenses incurred by illegal acts during the lease Period, such as traffic fines. Parking fees, toll fees, and motorcycle impoundment/seizure fees (if any).

2.14.2 If Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. has to act on behalf of the customer in payment or management of documents; Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. may charge a processing fee as described in Annex 1.

2.15 LIABILITY OF THE PARTIES

2.15.1 The Renter is liable for any damage to the motorcycle and third parties caused by the Renter's use, negligence, or breach of contract/law.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Company is not liable for indirect or consequential losses (missed flights, accommodations, business losses, etc.) and is not liable for loss of personal belongings.

Nothing in this Agreement limits liability where such limitation is prohibited by applicable Thai law, including controlled contract requirements and consumer protection rules. [Ref 2, Ref 3]

2.15.2 The Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. does not exclude or limit the liability to the lessee in the event of a breach of contract or willful/gross negligence, or in the event of a defect of the motorcycle that the Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. should be aware of and has not reasonably corrected. This is in accordance with the law. ***Review Nomad X Release of Liability & Defects**

2.16 TERMINATION

2.16.1 The Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. has the right to terminate the contract when the lessee breaches the contract or violates material conditions, such as allowing others to drive without permission, drunk driving, refusing to return the motorcycle, destroying/turning off the GPS system, taking the motorcycle out of the Kingdom, suspected fraud, or general misuse of motorcycle according to Clause 2.6. Nomad X Treme Bikes also reserves the right to refuse use or rental at its own discretion, for example an inexperienced rider or other related issues or similar reasons.

2.16.2 Upon termination of the contract under Clause 2.16.1, the Renter shall return the motorcycle immediately and the Renter shall be entitled to charge the necessary costs for the recovery of the motorcycle and the actual damages.

2.16.3 Nomad X treme Bikes & Delivery Co. Ltd. shall not terminate the contract without cause or when the customer has not breached the Contract/Material Conditions.

2.17 FORCE MAJEURE

2.17.1 The parties shall not be liable for any delay or failure to perform the contract caused by force majeure events such as disasters, floods, etc. Government orders or reasons beyond reasonable control. The parties must notify the other party as soon as possible and try to minimize the damage.

2.18 GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

2.18.1 This Agreement is governed by the laws of the Kingdom of Thailand.

2.18.2 In the event of a dispute, the parties shall first try to negotiate in good faith or mediation with a mediator based in Thailand. If unsuccessful, the lawsuit shall be filed with the courts of competent jurisdiction in Phuket, unless otherwise required by the Consumer Protection Law.
